**LANGUAGE:** The workshop will be held in English.

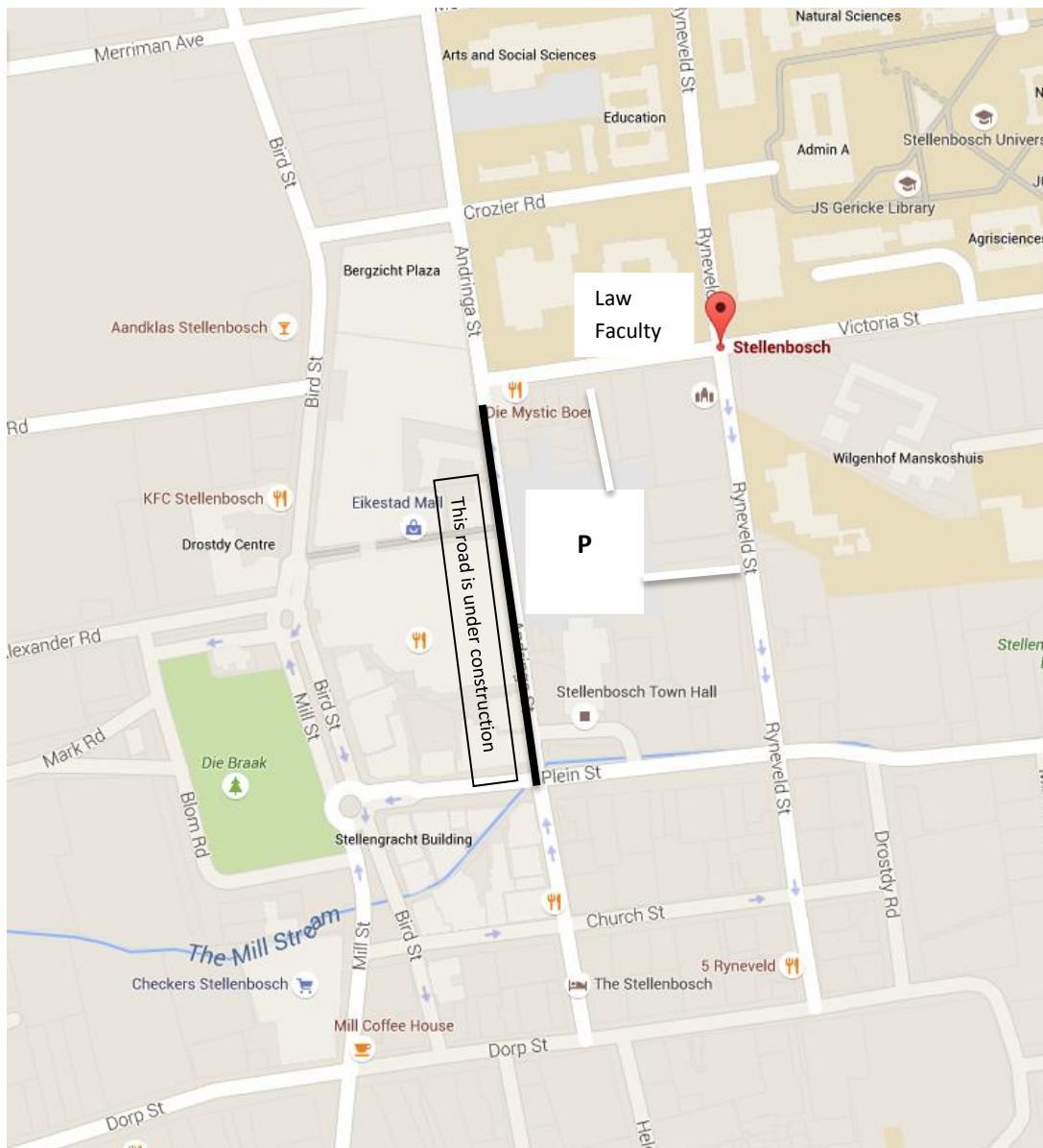
**POWER:** South Africa has been experiencing daily power outages which affect mobile networks, the internet, etc. We recommend you charge your phone and laptop whenever you get a chance. Standard voltage is 230V, three plug with large grounded top socket. Adaptors are available at the local Eikestad Mall and many hotels use standard two-plug European sockets.

**CURRENCY:** The official currency is the South African Rand (\$1=R11.95). We recommend you use cards which are widely accepted or exchange money before arriving as extensive paperwork is required in South Africa as per Reserve Bank policies.

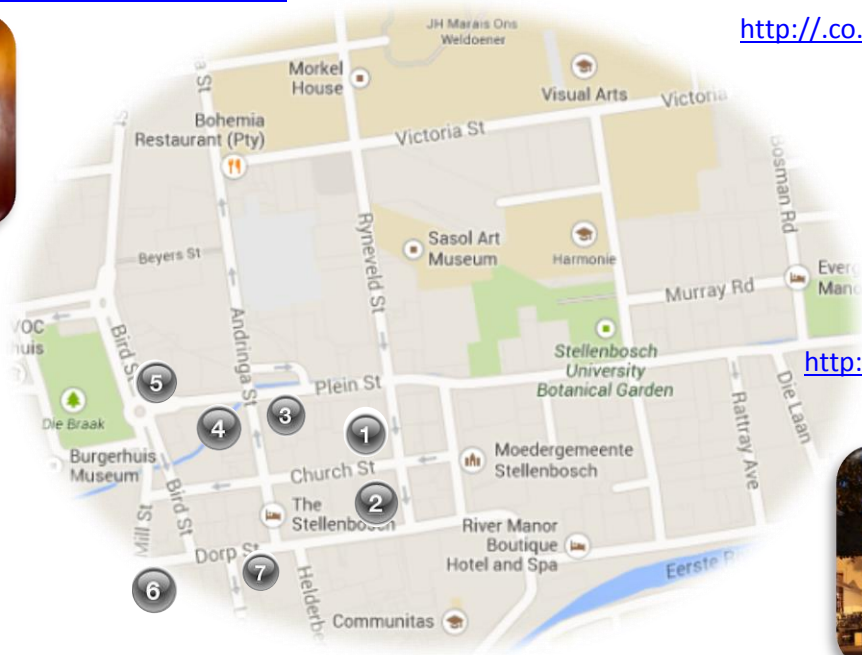
